History: The Mina Elementary School was constructed in 1925 and has been owned by Mineral County School District (MCSD) since. The Mina Elementary Library, a duplex located next to the Mina Elementary building, was constructed in 1940. Based on information obtained through the interview process, this building was used as a library and teacher housing quarters until the school closed in 2001.

Environmental Work: A Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) was conducted in October 2016. Based on the findings of the Phase I ESA, additional environmental investigation was recommended to identify potential releases of petroleum hydrocarbons, asbestos-containing materials, lead-based paint, and vapor migration into the Mina Elementary building via the unfinished basement with open access to the crawlspace beneath the building. Environmental reports are available upon request.

Existing Condition: The Mina Elementary School building is currently in use for storage of dry goods associated with graveside décor (plastic flowers, crosses, etc.).

Future Use: Redevelopment options were being considered by Mineral County School District.
